RULES: This match is to be fired using USA Shooting rules and as modified by this match

bulletin.

ELIGIBILITY: This match is open to all shooters, no membership or age requirements

apply.

MEMBERSHIP: No membership requirements apply; however, all shooters and / or their

families are encouraged to be members of the Oklahoma Rifle Association.

Membership applications will be available on site.

EQUIPMENT/CLASSES: This competition is open to both Sporter and Precision Air Rifle

Classes. Each participant must bring all of their own equipment. A limited amount of Compressed Air will be available. We are unable to provide CO₂. As this match is to be fired on non-moving paper targets, spotting scopes are allowed.

There is only one class for air pistol

SET UP AND SIGHT IN PERIOD: A 15 minute set up and sight in period will start 15

minutes prior the start of the relay. For the first relay this period will start at 8:45 am. For subsequent relays this period will start as soon as the preceding

relay has removed their equipment from the firing line.

COURSE OF FIRE:

Air Rifle: The course of fire is 12 shots for record in 17 minutes on paper targets, 5 targets for record. Targets to be changed by range staff after each 17 minute period of firing.

Air Pistol: The course of fire is 12 shots for record in 17 minutes on paper targets, 5 targets for record. Targets to be changed by range staff after each 17 minute period of firing.

TARGETS: Air rifle targets are the AR / 10. There are 12 bullseyes on this target, all 12 bullseyes will be used for score, one shot for record on each bullseye.

Air pistol targets are the B 40/4. There are 4 bullseyes on this target, 3 shots for record on each bullseye.

RELAYS: Relays will start as follows:

Relay 1: 9:00 am, set up and sight in period will start at 8:45
Relay 2 11:00 am or a soon as the first relay has cleared the line.
Relay 3 1:00 pm or as soon as the previous relay has cleared the line
Relay 4 3:00 pm or as soon as the previous relay has cleared the line.

SCORING: Targets will be hand scored by the Scoring Committee.


SCORING PROTEST: A 15 minute protest period will begin immediately after the Scoring Committee has completed scoring the targets for each relay and returned the targets to the shooter. A Protest should be brought to the attention of the Scoring Committee Director. The Scoring Committee will re-examine the shot being protested and render a decision. The decision of the Scoring Committee after this re-examination is final.

AWARDS: State champion trophies will be awarded to the top air rifle shooter and to the top air pistol shooter. Additional awards will be given to the first, second and third place shooters in each category. An awards ceremony will take place as soon as the final relay is over and the protest period has lapsed.

No person may receive more than one award, except in the case of an individual shooting in both an air rifle match and the air pistol match. The award recipient must be present to received their award.

ENTRY FEES: The entry fee is \$30 for each shooter in each category.
